PROJECT UPDATES

The DWSRF grant we applied for will fund two separate district-wide improvement projects. The first project includes the installation of SCADA on April 20 where we collected bids from a handful of contractors, bids were closed at 10:30 a.m. on April 20th we then held a special meeting Thursday April 23rd for the bid awarding, where the board voted on what contractors would be awarded to each project. Project 1, the purchase and installation of the AMR Smart Meters was awarded to Utility Technology Services (UTS) and Project 2, the SCADA, was awarded to D6 Labs. We expect and hope things move fast so we will keep you all updated through the whole process!
